### PGA of SA Announces 2<sup>nd</sup> World Club ProAm

Entries for the second PGA of South Africa World Club ProAm are now open and the lucrative prize fund of US\$270 000 is back on the table along with the coveted championship title.

Chief Executive of the PGA of South Africa, Ivano Ficalbi, said, "Our inaugural event received acclaim from the 30 teams that entered from the four corners of the globe. The winner, Henrik Engdahl from the PGA of Sweden, won US\$33 000 and every Professional walked away with more than US\$1 900. Thanks to the sponsorship from our tournament partner, Taylormade, every Amateur participant travelled home with top of the range Taylormade golf equipment".

The prize fund in 2015 will be US\$270 000 with 1<sup>st</sup> to 60<sup>th</sup> sharing in US\$210 000. Every Professional is guaranteed a minimum appearance fee of US\$1 000 even if they fail to finish in the top 60. The Professionals compete in an Individual Stableford format while the team competes in a ProAm 4-ball alliance. With no cut at any stage for either competition, the very last shot played could guarantee a win.

The tournament will be played from 14 – 21 February 2015 across 5 of KwaZulu-Natal's championship courses.

"Get in early and register firstly as a PGA golf professional to secure your spot. Entries per world region are limited and any region that is oversubscribed will go onto a waiting list to fill spaces not taken in other regions on a first come basis," said Event Management Director, Beverley Theron.
